

# Free Resources: ACT Test Fee Waivers

ACT® fee waivers are available to low-income 11th and 12th grade students in Virginia

## What do Fee Waivers Cover?

Fee waivers cover more than just the testing fees. When you register for the ACT or ACT Subject Tests™, the fee waiver will cover:

- **The registration fee for up to two ACTs**, with or without ACT Writing for National Saturday Test days
- **Free access to ACT Online Prep and ACT Kaplan Online Prep Live**

## Are You Eligible to Receive Fee Waivers?

Each student who receives an ACT Fee Waiver must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Be currently enrolled in high school in the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
2. Be a United States citizen or testing in the United States, U.S. Territories, or Puerto Rico.
3. Meet **one or more** of the indicators of economic need listed below:
  - Enrolled in a federal free or reduced-price lunch program at school, based on US Department of Agriculture (USDA) income levels.
  - Enrolled in a program for the economically disadvantaged (for example, a federally funded program such as GEAR UP or Upward Bound). **Note:** *If the student participates in a program, but is not economically disadvantaged, they are not eligible for a fee waiver.*
  - Resides in a foster home, is a ward of the state, or is homeless.
  - Family receives low-income public assistance or lives in a federally subsidized public housing.
  - Family's total annual income is at or below USDA levels for free or reduced-price lunches (see table).

## How to Register with a Fee Waiver

- Follow the “Student Directions” on the ACT Fee Waiver Form for your registration method.
- Each waiver has a serial number printed in the top-right corner. Instructions for submitting the serial number online or returning the fee waiver form with a paper registration are on the printed form under “How to Apply this Fee Waiver”.

- Students registering online must pay any fees not covered by the waiver with a credit card before submitting the registration.
- Each request is valid only if it is properly completed and personally signed by both the student and a school/agency/ official.

## Apply to Colleges—For Free

College application fees can really add up, but there's good news! Students who take the ACT fee waiver may also request a Waiver or Deferral of College Admission Applications Fee. This form is available here: [www.act.org/the-act/resources](http://www.act.org/the-act/resources)

## Using College Application Fee Waivers

To have a college application fee waived, students must submit their fee waiver directly to the college they are applying to (NOT to ACT).

Most colleges and universities define eligibility for a college application fee waiver as being eligible for or having received a fee waiver for a test such as the ACT, participating in the National School Lunch Program, or receiving public assistance.
