General Information About the ACM

The Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) and the state higher education agencies of the participating states administer Academic Common Market (ACM) program.* The program operates on the premise that if public institutions in a student's home state do not offer a degree program (undergraduate or graduate) that a student intends to pursue, then he/she may attend a participating out-of-state institution offering the degree of interest and be granted a waiver of out-of-state tuition charges. (No private institutions participate in the ACM program.)

To be eligible for the ACM...

The academic major:

1. Must not be offered at a public institution in Virginia.
2. Must be approved by the VA ACM Coordinator and the out-of-state institution.

And the student:

1. Must be a legal resident of Virginia.
2. Must be unconditionally admitted into an approved ACM program.

* Please be aware that although Florida, North Carolina, and Texas are SREB states, they participate in the ACM at the graduate level only. Additionally, certain institutions place restrictions on ACM access. For more information on ACM restrictions, please see the "Policies and Procedures" section on the ACM website.
