Virginia's Public Two-Year Colleges

For centuries, Virginians have recognized the importance of higher education and supported it. The College of William and Mary, established in 1693, is the second oldest higher education institution in the nation. The Commonwealth has devoted public funds to higher education since the founding of Thomas Jefferson's University of Virginia in 1819.

Virginia's General Assembly established the Virginia Community College System in 1966. In its over 40 year of service, the VCCS has established a reputation for educational excellence. As a result of these and other ongoing commitments, the people of Virginia now have access to one of the most highly respected state-supported (or public) systems of higher education in the country.

Today, Virginia's system of higher education includes 24 public two-year colleges and universities. There are 23 community colleges, located on 40 campuses that serve more than 240,000 students. In addition, community colleges help meet the needs of Virginia business by providing more than 190,000 students with workforce training.

Richard Bland College (RBC) is another public two-year institution. It is Virginia's only public junior college and serves more than 1,400 students each year. RBC offers a traditional curriculum in the liberal arts and sciences, and prepares students to transfer to public and private institutions across the country.

The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) is charged by the Governor and General Assembly with coordinating Virginia's entire higher education system. Virginia's public and private colleges and universities, which serve over 428,000 students of all ages, constitute the 11th largest higher education system in the nation.
